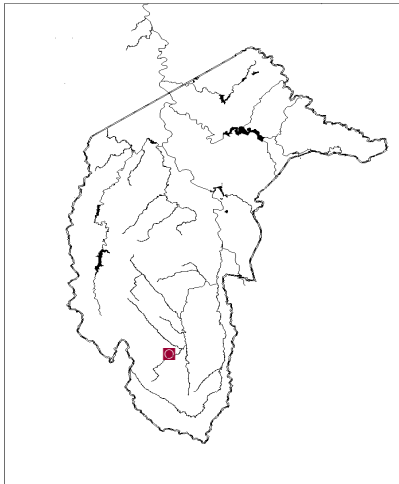


Bogong Creek Central—Gudgenby

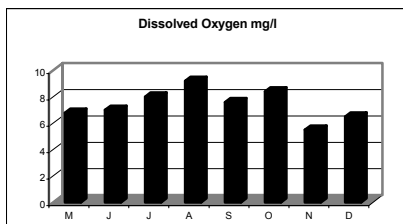
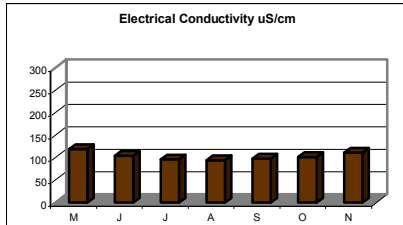
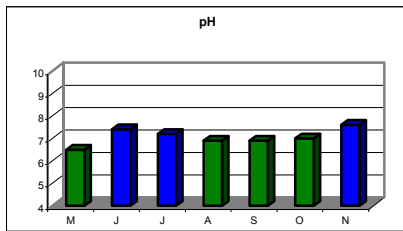
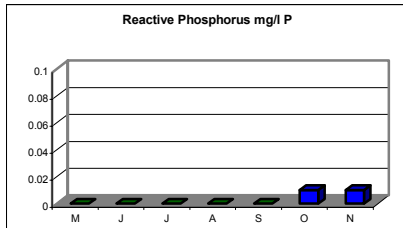
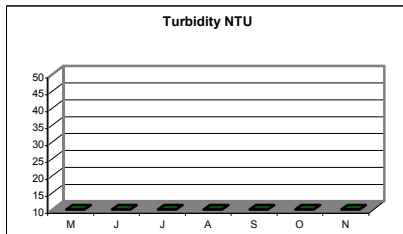
- June: Creek is a minor tributary of Bogong Creek and flows through a grassy water course. Condition of the grass is good and the immediate area was not affected by the fires.
- August: Algae is probably Spirogyra—it had a soapy feel and was formed into filaments.
- September: Creek banks were grassy, no sign of frogs, few aquatic plants. Water had a slight grey colour to it.
- October: Kangaroo carcass still intact.
- November: Kangaroo carcass well on the way to decomposition.
