Register

Water Resources Act 2007

FACTSHEET

Issued: 10 June 2009

Section 66 of the *Water Resources Act 2007* (the new Act) instructs the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) to create and maintain a register that includes details of the following:

- Water access entitlements granted;
- Surviving allocations in force;
- Licences to take water issued;
- Driller's licences issued;
- Bore work licences issued;
- Waterway work licences issued;
- Recharge licences issued; and
- Any transfers of water access entitlements.

The register may also include other information provided to, or collected by the EPA.

The register is available for inspection by appointment, and is located at 12 Wattle Street, Lyneham ACT. EPA officers can make electronic searches of the register upon request; however fees are applicable for such searches.
