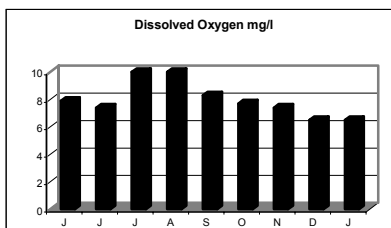
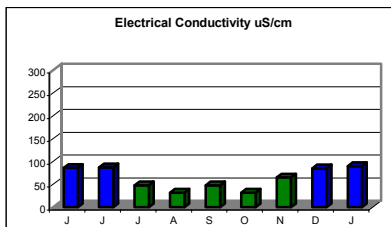
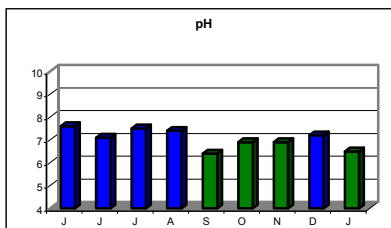
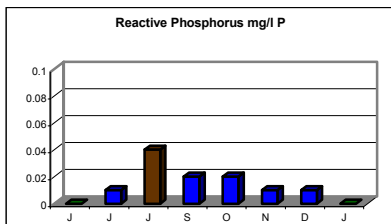
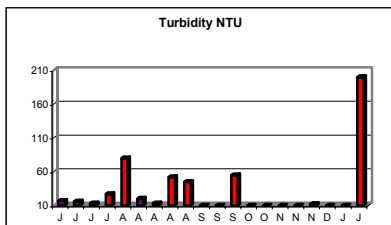


Participant Comments: G. Hall & J. Goodrum

- Area was severely burnt after the fires.
- July: Water had sour smell, thin layer of algae visible covering some submerged surfaces.
- August: Substantial rain in the past 24 hours, run off substantial with soil still exposed.
- Wildlife includes kookaburra, kangaroos, magpies, echidnas, ants, kingfishers, frogs, robins, fantails, yellow faced honeyeaters.
- Lots of weeds, thistles and blackberries.
- After flooding lots of black mud deposits left on bank.
