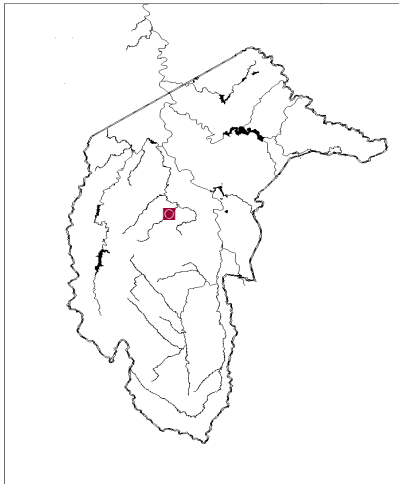


# Gibraltar Creek—Lower Site



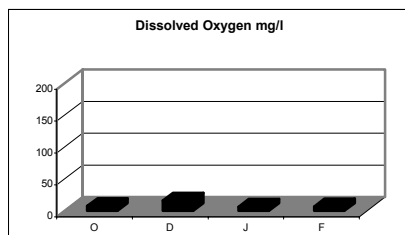
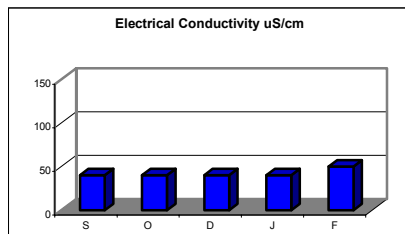
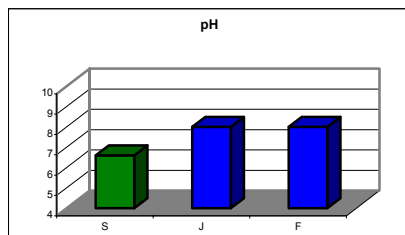
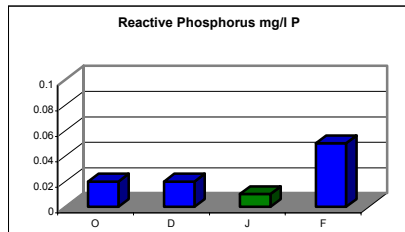
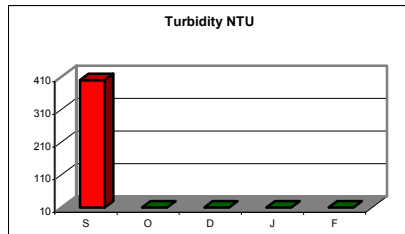
## Participant Comments: The Fed's

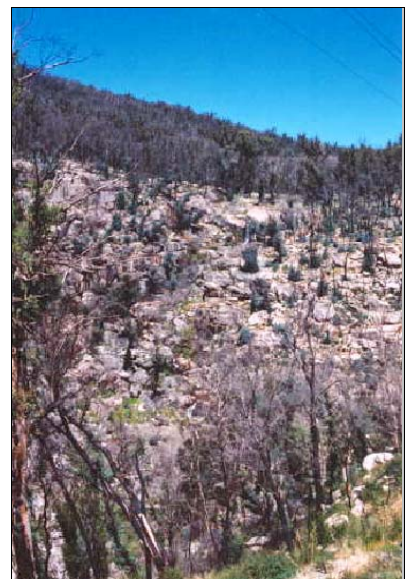
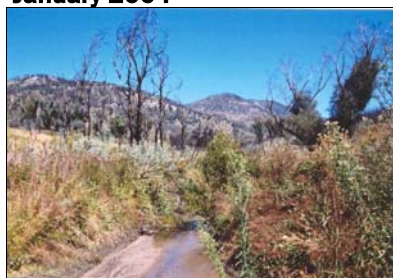
