A driller's licence can be granted for a period of up to 3 years and is subject to conditions which are specified in the licence. Possession of a current interstate licence equivalent to at least a National Drillers Licence Class 1 can qualify an applicant for an ACT Driller's Licence.

I understand that under section 37(2) of the *Water Resources Act 2007* the holder of a driller's licence commits an offence if:

- (a) the person does bore work on land; and
- (b) the owner or occupier of the land does not have a bore work licence for the bore work.
