- May: Creek a series of pools with a small flow between each. This section of creek is in the middle of a swamp that had been completely burnt in the fires. Still much bare earth.
- June: Water flowing through the burnt remains of sphagnum and other swamp species.
- July: Grass regeneration is good but the swamp plants are showing no sign of regrowth as yet.
- October: No algae in flowing water. About 50% cover in still water.
- December: Prolific riparian plant growth—signs of Jan 2003 bushfires all but gone!
