Under the current, 2007 Planning & Development Legislation, The public can submit a Controlled Activity Order Application, the Authority can decide on what action to take in regards to a Controlled Activity Order application lodged by the public. This is covered in section 351 of the act.

The planning and land authority can decide to:

- to make a controlled activity order of the kind sought; or
- to make a controlled activity order (including a different kind of order) that is not more burdensome than the order application or
- not to make a controlled activity order.

Can you please provide copies of all of the Controlled Activity Order Applications lodged in the past 2 years and the decision / response from the 'Planning and Land Authority' for each of these order applications.

For each of these applications did the Authority decide to:

- Make a controlled activity order,
- make a modified or reduced controlled Activity order; or
- decided not to make a controlled activity order

I understand that there are three Directorates involved in receiving, assessing and determining the outcome of Controlled Activity order Applications, therefore I address this FOI enquiry to all three.
