### **Block 49 Section 132 WANNIASSA 'Brick Banks' at the Erindale Skatepark WANNIASSA**

According to the nomination application, the brick banks are the last remaining man curved brick structures that were built around the Erindale college and library in the 1980s. Due to the high level of skill required to use the facility effectively, the Erindale banks are unique and iconic enough to have attracted international coverage in skateboarding media.

The brick banks are the last remaining of the brick embankment structures in a larger set that contributed to the consistent design in the Erindale area throughout the 80s and 90s.
