Freedom of Information 23/117128

I refer to your application made under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act) received by the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD) on 13 November 2023 in which you sought access to web platforms related to renewable energy that have received funding from the ACT Government.

We note your application was made under the *Commonwealth Freedom of Information Act 1982* however, we are processing your request under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016*.

The refined below scope as provided by you on the 15 December 2023 is specifically seeking:

"Can the department please confirm if RenewMap Pty Ltd (<https://renewmap.com.au>) and/or its proprietors **received funding** via the ACT Government Renewable Energy Innovation Fund (REIF) and if so, what was the monetary amount."

The information you are seeking is for the time frame 1 January 2022 – 1 November 2023.

I am an Information Officer appointed under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

EPSDD must make a decision on your application on or by 2 January 2024.

Searches Conducted

Comprehensive searches were conducted by EPSDD's Climate Change and Emissions Branch teams for documents relevant to your application. However, no relevant documentation containing information relevant to your application was identified.

Decision on Access

Searches were conducted using the information you provided, including additional Directorate database searches.

I am satisfied that a thorough process was completed in an effort to locate the information you are seeking. I have therefore decided, under section 35(1)(b) of the Act, that no documents are held by EPSDD that are relevant to your application.

Online Publication

Under section 28 of the Act, EPSDD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application and this decision will be published in the EPSDD disclosure log no earlier than three days after you receive this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published.

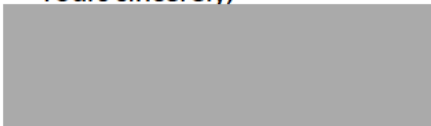
