TWO SCARRED TREES – POSSIBLE SCARRED TREE 1 & MHW ST2 (KOWEN, MAJURA) Rural Block 66 KOWEN & Rural Block 681 MAJURA

On 27 January 2019 ACT Heritage received a nomination for Two Scarred Trees - Possible Scarred Tree 1 and MHW ST2. The nominator with Registered Aboriginal Organisations (RAOs) identified the scar on Possible Scarred Tree 1 as identical to a cultural scar on a tree already registered in the vicinity. Possible Scarred Tree 1 is an unknown species that has been felled. The nominator and RAOs confidently identified the scar on MHW ST2 as cultural in origin. MHW ST2 is a still living Applebox tree of considerable age in declining condition.
