**ROCHE HOUSE
4 BEDFORD STREET
BLOCK 12, SECTION 48, DEAKIN**

The nomination asserts that Roche House was designed by Robin Boyd in 1954 for local doctor Hilary Roche, in the early stages of the Grounds, Romberg and Boyd partnership. It is a good example of Boyd's more economical designs from the early 1950s.

The house is typical of the post-war Melbourne regional architectural style, with its long unbroken roofline, wide eaves and large areas of glass with regularly spaced timber mullions.
