

Terms of Reference for the Reserve Sub-committees established by the Committee of the Capital Woodland and Wetlands Conservation Association Inc.

The role of the Jerrabomberra Wetlands Nature Reserve (JWNR) Management Sub-Committee is to:

- Foster a spirit of partnership with ACT Parks and Conservation Service (TAMS) and Conservation Planning and Research (EPD) and other stakeholders (including the National Capital Authority) in delivering programs for JWNR.
- Oversee, guide and support planning and delivery of strategic developments, management programs and operational plans for JWNR, including preparation of relevant documents.
- Provide direction, expert advice and support to the Manager of JWNR, including prioritisation of actions.
- Assist the Committee in harnessing community-wide support for and participation in the programs and activities in JWNR (including contributions to the Trust, voluntary (or in-kind) support, and sponsorships).
- Monitor the effectiveness of conservation, management and other programs delivered in JWNR.
- Undertake review and assessment of development and management proposals on lands in and adjacent to the JWNR (which may have implications for the conservation of its natural and cultural values and any research programs) and make submissions and representations to relevant agencies.
- Provide advice to the Committee, Directorates (TAMS/EPD), and ACT Parks and Conservation Service (as the Territory's land-owner and public land manager) on progress in achieving delivery of plans, strategies and projects for JWNR.
- Keep the Minister informed of activities and programs within and adjacent to JWNR.
- Provide quarterly reports to the Committee on the Sub-committee's activities, membership and other appropriate matters.
- Review the appropriateness of these ToR in respect to their effectiveness in delivering the objectives of the Plan of Management and Master Plan, and recommend to the Committee any necessary changes.
