This request is made with the presumption of release under Section 7 of the *2016 Freedom of Information Act* and is made in the public interest which is to have available information which allows the public to see how government and its agencies operate.

It meets the objectives of Section 6 of the Act and is prompted by the recent well documented interest in the current CRS draft EIS201700053 process which has received some 464 public submissions overwhelmingly rejecting the location of a major waste facility and intermodal freight hub in the Canberra Central region of Fyshwick, which concerns Block 9 Section 8 and the contiguous Block 11 Section 8.

[REDACTED] requests that all processing fees be waived as the information is of special benefit to a substantial section of the public. When considered as a whole with the other related Fyshwick waste hub proposals it has a wider general public interest because of the redevelopments' 'High Risk' nature and the potential for harm to the environment, human health and public safety.
