### **Block 13 Section 2 FORREST**

#### **9 Ord Street FORREST**

The residence at 9 Ord Street is an interesting building because it has a few components of two architectural styles, the Inter-War Chicagoesque Style (1915-1940) and the Post-War American Colonial Style (1940-1960). The design incorporates two principal features which were peculiar to the Inter-War Chicagoesque Style with its grid-like facade expressing storey divisions and porticos referencing the Post-War American Colonial Style (1940-1960).
