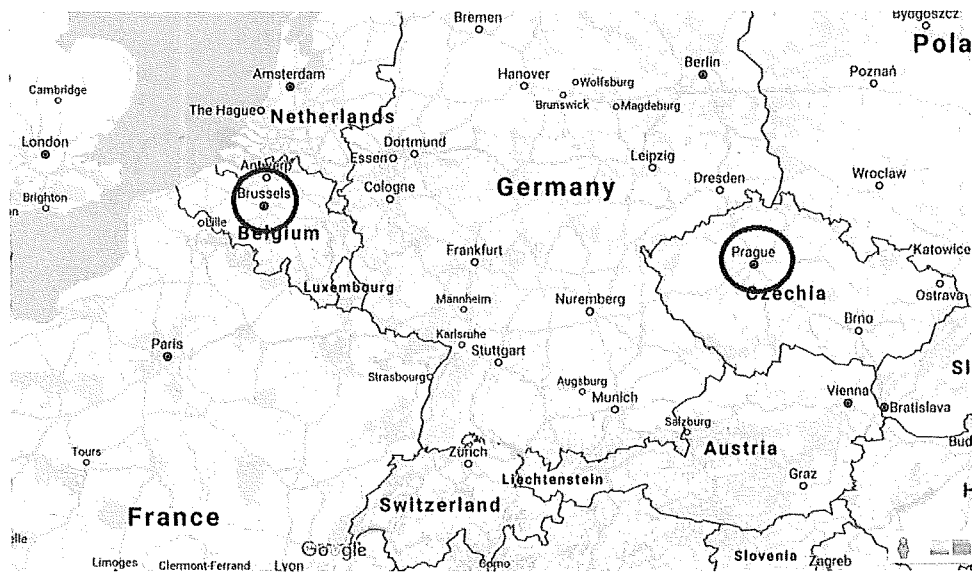

Introduction

World Cities is a project of the Directorate General for Regional and Urban Policy (DG REGIO) of the European Commission in the framework of the European Parliament's preparatory action to promote the exchange of experience and best practice between the European Union and non-EU countries on territorial development with particular reference to urban development, urban-rural partnerships and urban cross-border cooperation. Actions are designed to increase so-called 'triple-helix cooperation' between governments, research and business.

The programme is designed for representatives of Canberra ACT meeting counterparts in Prague and then visiting the EU Headquarters in Brussels. After the mission, the Canberra representatives will travel to Copenhagen, Berlin and – on the way back to Australia – to Singapore.

Draft Itinerary: EU Delegation 26 August to 7 September 2017

The ACT Government has an ambitious program of sustainable development and urban renewal initiatives that will transform Canberra. The EU Delegation will provide the opportunity to visit best practice examples of urban innovation, Smart City initiatives and environmental sustainability throughout Europe and Singapore. The itinerary is shaped around five core themes, which relate to current and future projects in the ACT. The itinerary outlines a series of destinations/activities for the delegation to visit in each city and identifies how these items relate to the five key themes and ACT Government policies.

Themes:

1. **Design Innovation:** Best practice architecture and urban design, with a focus on the integration of technology and the built form.
2. **Sustainable Development:** Carbon-neutral development with a focus on renewable energy and green buildings.
3. **Green Infrastructure and Parks:** Sustainable open spaces, parks and green infrastructure located in urban environments.
4. **Community-led Initiatives and Placemaking:** Community-led innovation in placemaking, activation and urban initiatives.
5. **Integration with Smart City technology:** Integrating urban development with information and communications technology.
