Please accept this request under the *ACT Freedom of Information Act 2016* for the following information;

- the amount of the fees received as public monies for Development Application (DA) 202037590 and
- copies of any failure notices should such have been issued in regard to the development application.

I would draw to your attention the advice from the proponent in the online news RiotACT article dated 26 November 2020 (link below) in which was stated the amount of \$70,000 to be paid for the lodgment of DA202037590. If this is the correct amount it is public knowledge. My request under FOI intends to confirm or reject this CRS advice.

The proponent, Capital Recycling Solutions, has written twice to both Planning Minister Mick Gentleman and Transport and City Services Minister Chris Steel seeking clarity before it spends \$70,000 officially lodging its submitted development application.

Previously, it took 4 months until documents pertaining to the CRS Response to the Arup Review (allowed outside of normal procedure), were released. Following refusal from the proponent a further month was waited out for any appeal to the ombudsman, which did not eventuate. The credibility of CRS is relevant to consideration of any of the company's proposals. The CRS DA202037590 was lodged on 24 November 2020 and will shortly be notified for public representation. I would greatly appreciate confirmation of the monies paid in lodgment to be clarified prior to closure of notification. It would be in the interests of CRS to have this information public in support of the company's integrity.
