We will:

- Comply to all applicable regulations, laws, ACT Code of Forest Practice and national forest certification standards
- Provide appropriate employment conditions and look after work, health and safety wellbeing of all employees under the ACT Forest Management Unit
- Be inclusive and engage with potential and identified stakeholders with an interest during the operational decision-making process
- Manage ACT plantations with considerations to maintain and enhance positive social, economic and environmental outcomes
- Conserve, manage and rehabilitate environmental and ecological values, and commit to limit impacts by forestry operations
- Have appropriate operation and risk planning in accordance with the policies and procedures as stated in the Code of Forest Practice. Also, ensuring relevant records keeping is in place for regular, at least annual, review to achieve best forest management practices
- Ensure appropriate monitoring and assessment program is in place to monitor progress in achieving ACT Forest Management’s management objectives by setting and measuring verifiable targets
- Implement mitigation actions to limit impacts from forestry operations to High Conservation Values within the plantations
- Conduct the management activities in accordance with ACT Parks and Conservation’s and certification’s economic, environmental, and social principles.
