### **Freedom of Information 22/133873**

I refer to your application made under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act) received by the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD) on 6 October 2022 in which you sought access to briefing papers produced by EPSDD regarding City Stadium and the GIO Stadium in 2022.

Specifically, you are seeking:

*“...a copy of any briefing papers produced by the directorate, and /or commissioned consultants or 3<sup>rd</sup> parties in relation to the City Stadium and the GIO Stadium in 2022.”*

I am an Information Officer appointed under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

EPSDD must make a decision on your application on or by 3 November 2022.

### **Searches Conducted**

Comprehensive searches were conducted by the City Renewal Authority for documents relevant to your application. However, no relevant documentation containing information relevant to your application was identified.



### **Decision on Access**

Searches were conducted using the information you provided, including additional Directorate database searches.

I am satisfied that a thorough process was completed in an effort to locate the information you are seeking. I have therefore decided, under section 35(1)(b) of the Act, that no documents are held by EPSDD that are relevant to your application.

### **Online Publication**

Under section 28 of the Act, EPSDD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application and this decision will be published in the EPSDD

disclosure log no earlier than three days after you receive this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published.

### **Ombudsman Review**
