

# Public Sector Management (Financial Management Act 1996 – Financial Leases) Delegation 2017 (No 1)

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Public Sector Management (Financial Management Act 1996 – Financial Leases) Delegation 2017 (No 1)*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day that it is signed.

## 3 Delegation

I delegate such of my functions under section 31 and section 31A of the *Financial Management Act 1996* (the Act), as are reasonably necessary and convenient for entering into and implementing contracts and other agreements with the approved ACT Government fleet provider for the leasing of motor vehicles to the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate, to the persons who from time to time occupy the public service positions of E00558 and E00562.

### Examples

- 1 Signing finance lease agreements with the approved ACT Government fleet provider;
- 2 Authorising payments required for the purpose of finance lease agreements; and
- 3 Preparing and authorising associated documentation for managing the finance lease agreements.


*Note 1: The Legislation Act defines “occupy”, in relation to a position, as including: to hold the position, act in the position or exercise functions of the position.*

*Note 2: Under section 31(2)(c) of the Act, officers and employees of the directorate must comply with the Act including any instruments made under the Act such as the Financial Management Guidelines.*

*Note 3: At the time of making this instrument, public service position number E00558 is occupied by the Chief Operating Officer and E00562 is occupied by the Chief Finance Officer of the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate.*
