- 2 A report on the study is to be submitted to the Conservation Research Unit via Licensing and Compliance, at the completion of the study and/or prior to renewal of the licence to pcs.licensingandcompliance@act.gov.au or GPO Box 158, Canberra City, ACT 2602
- 3 This licence and any records required to be kept must be available for inspection by the Conservator of Flora and Fauna or any Conservation Officer.
- 4 This licence is to cover persons generally throughout the ACT working under the licence holders direction during the project period for the purposes of the project as authorised above.
- 5 Hands must be thoroughly washed after touching feathers or gloves must be worn when handling
- 6 Feathers collected must be stored in an envelope with the date, location of collection, name of collector and contact phone number.
- 7 Feathers must be posted or given to the licence holder within ten days of collection.
- 8 This licence does not confer any right of entry to ACT leased land of any kind. Approval must be sought from any lessee to enter leasehold land
- 9 A copy of this licence must be made available for viewing
