Wybalena Grove Block 1 Section 37 COOK

Wybalena Grove is significant as an urban medium density housing development situated within a natural bushland setting which, under the auspices of the NCDC, was procured through communal and co-operative processes for the purpose of demonstrating a socially responsible residential alternative and environmentally sensitive form of housing. The natural bushland setting and the introduced native landscape, the use of materials (dark brick, tile and timbers) and the building forms provide a special natural aesthetic response of unique qualities for a medium density housing project.
