## JARDINE STREET COMMERCIAL AND BANKING ROW BLOCKS 25-32, SECTION 22, KINGSTON

The row of commercial and banking buildings was part of the expansion of the Kingston Shopping Precinct during the 1950s and was specifically set aside for commercial and banking purposes to complement the importance of the shopping Precinct and the adjoining Post Office. Its low formal mid-century aesthetic is a part of the streetscape that makes up the Kingston Shopping Precinct, and specifically the Green Square section.

The nomination application for Jardine Street Commercial and Banking Row was accepted by the Council on 12 November 2020.
