Freedom of Information 20/08931

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD) on 20 February 2020, in which you sought access to documentation relating to a presentation given by Minister Rattenbury.

Specifically, you are seeking:

"...any and all documentation relating to a presentation given by Minister Rattenbury to the Inner South Canberra Community Council on the 11th February 2020. This is including but not limited to, any correspondence from the Minister's office, any briefing notes, files or slideshows prepared by the directorate for the purpose of the presentation."

I am an Information Officer appointed under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

EPSDD is required to make a decision on your access application by or on 20 March 2020.

Searches Undertaken

Comprehensive searches of EPSDD recordkeeping systems and information held by staff of relevant business areas were undertaken. However, no documentation relevant to your application was identified.

Decision

I am satisfied that a thorough process was completed in effort to locate the information you are seeking. I have therefore decided, under section 35 (1)(b) of the Act, that no documents relevant to your application are held by EPSDD.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this request, in accordance with section 107 of the Act.

Online Publication

Under section 28 of the Act, EPSDD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application and my decision in response to your access

application will be published in the EPSDD disclosure log from three to ten days after you are provided this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published.
