WOLSELEY RD RESERVE**

The Ainslie Aboriginal and Geological Heritage Values nomination area sits at the base of Mount Ainslie at 590m and covers several outcrops of Mount Ainslie Volcanics that help to show the spread of rock types within the formation from the site type localities near the top of the mountain at 810m, 1.6km to the north-east, as well as the quarry area at 660m, near the base of the mountain 1km to the south-east-east. The area has also been nominated for Aboriginal heritage values associated with the outcrops by material culture and intangible heritage values.
